SPECIFICATIONS FOR 50 NET HP COMPACT EXCAVATOR**

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this specification is to establish a purchasing requirement for a 54 minimum horsepower diesel engine compact excavator with an enclosed cab and accessories, for use by the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Agencies, and other Public Bodies of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

SCOPE:

The following specifications are intended to define the minimum level of quality, performance, and suitability for the intended purpose of a quantity of **one (1)** compact excavator with an enclosed cab, and associated attachment equipment, and are meant to be met or exceeded. Where brand names are used, the specifications are NOT meant to be restrictive as to brand name or manufacturer. All equipment bid may be the brand name and model, or shall be **equivalent** to brand names and/or any other specification elements using the **Use of Brand Names** clause (see General Terms and Conditions) in making an equivalence determination

BIDDER REQUIREMENTS:

Bidders/Vendors shall submit complete technical data and product catalog information of the products being offered, with an itemized comparison of the products offered with these specifications. Bidders/Vendors shall indicate equivalence on the specifications form next to each specification item, using the lines provided across from the specification items. The Commonwealth reserves the right to obtain technical data and to request clarification when deemed necessary. **Failure on the part of the bidder/Vendor to provide all requested documentation may be cause to reject the bid/request as non-responsive.**

The equipment offered in answer to this request for bid must be a new and unused current production model of the equipment required. No prototype, or demonstrator, or rebuilt product will be accepted, and offering of such a product will be cause for bid rejection.

Bidders shall provide delivery for products offered, FOB destination. Deliver to Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Clinch Mountain Wildlife Management Area Equipment Depot, 2324 Tumbling Creek Road, Saltville, VA 24370, between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM Monday thru Friday. Contact Mr. Mark Robinett at (276) 782-2024 not less than 48 hours prior to delivery. Provide delivery lead time after receipt of order (ARO), in the "DELIVERY TIME...." section provided at the end of the specifications.

The compact excavator must be put in service by a qualified representative of the contractor at the delivery location. The representative must demonstrate that the excavator and all accessory equipment are operating correctly, with no defects in materials, manufacturing, or installation. The representative must operate the excavator, all the accessory equipment, and instruct user personnel in operation, safety requirements, and maintenance of the excavator and all accessory equipment.

Products provided must be warranted with the supplier's best warranty offered, to provide no-cost protection to the Commonwealth for correction or replacement as needed for defects in manufacturing, assembly, or parts. Minimum acceptable warranty is 12 months
